North shore tabletop and board gamers have a new place to enjoy their hobbies at the recently opened [D6 Lounge](#) on Pacific Highway at Roseville.

Owner Michael Pan and store manager Luke Cameron opened the doors to their well-stocked gaming haunt a few months ago to provid who play a range of tabletop battle games, card and board games and even role-playing activity.

"Our aim is to provide a friendly, welcoming environment where people can come and enjoy their hobbies, play against like-minded gamers," Mr Cameron said.

He said the store was born of frustration at a lack of suitable venues for role-playing games and collectable card games.

Appealing to the slightly older gamer, the D6 Lounge aims to cater for a range of games that don't usually have access to a dedicated place.

With a great range of 6x4 foot boards, tables and chairs, gamers have the perfect place to meet and play.

Mr Cameron said all tables were free of charge to use, and most could be used in a selection of terrain. Of with most of the boards having terrain that could be used.

"We only charge when people want to reserve a table for a whole day, for whatever game or activity they want to play," he said.

The D6 Lounge is stocked with snacks and drinks for purchase, to ensure gamers don't go hungry, and there is a dedicated space where and build models, paint, or just discuss rules and tactics.

Various games and items are also available for sale.

Mr Cameron said he hoped to build a core of regulars before running more adventurous competitions and leagues.

"Our aim is to provide a great atmosphere for gamers of all persuasions and ages," he said. "We're also keen for first timers or newcomers come in and see what the commotion is all about."
